# Practical ways to overcome adversity and persecution in sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ.

- 1. Know that you've been called. Paul and Barnabas knew that they were called by God for this very purpose. If God calls you to it, know that he will bring you through it.
- 2. Be bold in your witness. Share the gospel message in your own spheres of influence, whether it be among family, friends, colleagues, or even strangers. We must speak the truth in love, unapologetically sharing the good news of salvation through Jesus Christ.
- 3. Rely on God's power. Rather than relying solely on our own abilities, we should depend on the Holy Spirit to work through us, confirming the truth of the gospel through transformed lives and even miraculous interventions.
- 4. Persevere in ministry. Although we may encounter obstacles, resistance, or discouragement in our efforts to share the message of Jesus Christ, trust in God's strength and guidance in the face of adversity.
- 5. Be flexible in your ministry strategy. Sometimes, the most effective course of action may involve changing plans or locations as guided by the Holy Spirit. We are called to be open to God's leading and be willing to adjust our strategies for the sake of advancing His Kingdom.
