"ONE BAD DECISION – DREADFUL STORM"

 INSIGHT:

A STORM COULD BE A FINANCIAL HARDSHIP, A PERSONAL LOSS, A SICKNESS, OR TROUBLED RELATIONSHIP. WE CAN'T ALWAYS PREDICT STORMS AND WE CAN'T OUTRUN THEM BUT WE CAN NAVIGATE THROUGH THEM BY THE POWER AND PRESENCE OF GOD.

STORMS WILL COME, AND WHEN THEY DO, WE CAN DRAW CLOSER TO GOD THROUGH THEM AND EMERGE STRONGER AND BOLDER IN OUR FAITH.
